This project includes:

A new, single story Fire Station Building and associated site improvements will be constructed adjacent to the existing Fire Station Building. The existing building will remain operational while the new building is being constructed. Once the new building is completed and ready for occupancy, the existing building will be demolished. Once demolished, the balance of the sitework will be completed. Project also includes demolition of other structures on the site. The project will need to be completed in phases to maintain the existing building operations, contractor to coordinate with Fire Department. Refer to conceptual phasing plans included in the construction document set.
