The Charter Township of Canton is pursuing additional funding support to improve amenities at Victory Park, located at 46555 Michigan Avenue, Canton, MI 48188. The grant application will include improvements of accessible playground amenities, sand volleyball, athletic warm-up space, dugout improvements, and environmental sustainability features. This Public Hearing is being held to receive public input for application to the Recreation Passport Grant offered by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources aimed toward recreational amenity improvements at Victory Park.
