## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 36 OFFENSES TO ADD SECTION 36-325 OFFENSES INVLOCLVING UNMANNED AIRCRAFT OF THE CITY OF ROMULUSE CODE OF ORDINANCES

This ordinance is intended to supplement, not replace, FAA regulations. Where FAA regulations are more restrictive, they shall control. The City acknowledges that the FAA has exclusive authority over the national airspace system.

## THE CITY OF ROMULUS ORDAINS:

Sec. 36 Offenses is amended to add Sec. 36-325 involving unmanned aircraft is hereby added to Division 1 of Chapter 36 of the Code of the City of Romulus to read as follows:

Sec. 36 – 325. Unmanned aircraft:

## COMPLETE COPY OF ORDINANCE ON FILE IN THE CITY CLERK'S OFFICE, 11111 WAYNE ROAD, ROMULUS, MI.

Within forty-five (45) days after publication of any ordinance duly passed by the Council, a petition may be presented to the Council protesting against such ordinance continuing in effect. Said petition shall contain the text of such ordinance and shall be signed by not less than six percent (6%) of the registered electors registered at the last preceding election at which a Mayor of the City was elected. Said ordinance shall thereupon and thereby be suspended from operation and the Council shall immediately reconsider such ordinance.
