THE NORTHVILLE TOWNSHIP BROWNFIELD REDEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY**

Sealed Bids will be received by the Clerks Department, Second Floor, Northville Township Hall, on or before September 22, 2020 at 2:00 PM for the **Environmental Cleanup Activities at the Former Gun Range Parcel**. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time. **A MANDATORY pre-bid meeting will be held at the site on September 15, 2020 at 10:00 AM.**

Work to be done includes the **remediation of environmentally impacted soils** and all related work. Bid documents may be obtained on or after **August 24, 2020** from the office of the Department of Public Services, First Floor, Northville Township Hall, 44405 Six Mile Road, Northville, Michigan.

A fee of \$30.00 per set of documents will be charged. No refunds will be given for returned documents.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check, or Bid Bond by a recognized surety, in the amount of 5% of the total of the bid price. A proposal, once submitted, becomes the property of the Northville Township Brownfield Redevelopment Authority (NTBRA). In the sole discretion of the NTBRA, the NTBRA reserves the right to allow a bidder to reclaim submitted documents provided the documents are requested and retrieved no later than 48 hours prior to the scheduled bid opening.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory performance, maintenance, and labor and material bonds in the amount of 100% of the bid price and satisfactory insurance coverage.

After the time of opening, no Bid may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days. The NTBRA reserves the right to accept any Bid, to reject any or all Bids, to waive irregularities and/or informalities in any Bid, and to make the award in any manner the NTBRA believes to be in its best interest.
