## NOTICE TO THE RESIDENTS OF THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF NORTHVILLE

## PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE §53-17

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Charter Township of Northville Board of Trustees approved the adoption of the amendment to §53-17 (Keeping of Animals: Penalties) at a Regular Meeting on Thursday, February 16, 2023, at 7:00 P.M. at the Northville Township Hall located at 44405 Six Mile Road, Northville, Michigan 48168.

The approved amendment is as follows:

A. Any person who shall violate any provision of this chapter shall be subject to the penalties specified for a violation of the Township Code. However, only in the case of a violation of §53-4 a written warning shall be provided to the responsible party as follows:

The Chief of Police, or his/her designee, is authorized to serve a written notice of violation on the person responsible for any violation of the provisions of §53-4 which shall require compliance within 14 days of the notice.

Failure to comply with the written warning on a first offense or second offense shall result in the following penalty:

- a. The following civil fines shall apply in the event of a determination of responsibility for a municipal civil infraction, unless a different fine is specified in connection with a particular section:
  - *i.* First offense: The civil fine for a first offense violation shall be in the amount of \$300, plus costs and other sanctions, for each offense.
  - *ii.* Second offense: The civil fine for any offense which is a second offense shall be in an amount of \$500, plus costs and other sanctions for each offense.
- b. In addition to ordering the defendant determined to be responsible for a municipal civil fraction to pay a civil fine, costs, damages and expenses, the Judge or Magistrate shall be authorized to issue any judgment, writ or order necessary to enforce or enjoin violation of the chapter.
- c. Continuing offense. Each act of violation, and on each day upon which any such violation shall occur, shall constitute a separate offense.
- d. Remedies not exclusive. In addition to any remedies provided for by the Code of Ordinances, any equitable or other remedies available may be sought.
- e. The Judge or Magistrate shall be authorized to impose costs, damages and expenses provided by the law.
- f. A municipal civil infraction shall not be a lesser-included offense of a criminal offense or of an ordinance violation which is not a civil infraction.
- g. A third or subsequent offense shall be a misdemeanor punishable as set forth in §1-10 of the Township Code.

The introduction of the amendment was approved at the Board of Trustees Regular Meeting held on January 19, 2023.
