On Monday, March 9, 2020 qualified voters may be issued an absentee ballot in person, and shall vote them in the clerk's office until 4:00 p.m.

On Tuesday, March 10, 2020 a voter who registers to vote on Election Day by appearing in person at his or her clerk's office is

also eligible to obtain an absent voter ballot to vote in person at the clerk's office until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. To comply with the Help America Vote Act (HAVA), voting instructions will be available on audio tape and in Braille.

Arrangements for obtaining the instructions in these alternative formats can be made by contacting the township clerk in advance of the election. All polling locations are accessible for voters with disabilities.
