Notice is hereby given that the City of Romulus Planning Commission will hold a public hearing at **7:00 p.m.** on **MONDAY, December 15, 2025** for the purpose of considering the following:

- 1. Merriman School Romulus Self Storage requesting a zoning map amendment (rezoning) for:
 - a. RZ-2025-003; to rezone the front portion of a parcel (13 acres of 25.6-acres) from R1-A, Single Family Residential to M-1, Light Industrial for the purpose of redeveloping the former Merriman School to a self-storage facility located at 15303 Merriman Road (DP# 80-138-99-0006-000 and 80-138-99-0005-000.)
- 2. **Bradford Airport Logistics/WCAA** requesting a zoning map amendment (rezoning) for:
 - a. RZ-2025-004; to rezone 45.42 acres, DP# 80-130-99-0001-706, from C-3, Highway Business District to M-2, General Industrial for the purpose of developing a distribution facility to support DTW Airport operations.
- 3. Preliminary Draft of Future Land Use Map Amendments

The public hearings will be held at Romulus City Hall Council Chambers, 11111 Wayne Road.
