**AN ORDINANCE OF AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 38, PARKS, AND RECREATION.
THE CITY OF ROMULUS ORDAINS:**

Chapter 38 - PARKS AND RECREATION

ARTICLE I. - IN GENERAL

Sec. 38-15. - Use of intoxicants.

- (a) It shall be unlawful to consume alcoholic beverages or consume marihuana in or about vehicles parked in the parking lots and/or parking areas of all parks.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to bring within, sell, possess, give away or consume any alcoholic beverages or marihuana in the neighborhood parks.

Within forty-five (45) days after publication of any ordinance duly passed by the Council, a petition may be presented to the Council protesting against such ordinance continuing in effect. Said petition shall contain the text of such ordinance and shall be signed by not less than six percent (6%) of the registered electors registered at the last preceding election at which a Mayor of the City was elected. Said ordinance shall thereupon and thereby be suspended from operation and the Council considers such ordinance.
