**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-007**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 58 TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES, SECTION 58-66 AND SECTION 58-67.**

**THE CITY OF ROMULUS ORDAINS:**

Chapter 58 Sections 58-66 and 58-67 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 58-66. Defined.

Requires motor vehicle parking facilities to pay the required parking tax under MCL 207.371 et seq. and for motels or hotels and other establishments offering parking and fly to charge the fair value of parking storage for the parking period use and pay to the State Department of Treasury the parking tax.


Section 58-67. Entrance; exits; paving.

Prior to the issuance of any license, the department of public works and services shall cause an inspection to be made of the proposed parking facility and shall certify that the entrances and exits thereto from the public way have the proper curb cuts, and the space between the sidewalk and curb, where it is adjacent to the concrete roadway, shall be paved with concrete.

Within forty-five (45) days after publication of any ordinance duly passed by the Council, a petition may be presented to the Council protesting against such ordinance continuing in effect. Said petition shall contain the text of such ordinance and shall be signed by not less than six percent (6%) of the registered electors registered at the last preceding election at which a Mayor of the City was elected. Said ordinance shall thereupon and thereby be suspended from operation and the Council shall immediately reconsider such ordinance.
