

**INVITATION TO BID  
CITY OF ROMULUS  
ITB 25/26-19 PROJECT #0155-24-0070 EPA COMMUNITY GRANT PROJECT**

The City of Romulus is requesting sealed bids for the **EPA Community Grant Project**. The project is located at several addresses throughout the City. The work includes removing and replacing approximately 120 lead-water service lines located at various properties within the City limits. The water service lines may be replaced to the meter, located inside. The method of service line replacement will depend on the property; it may be completed by open trench installation or directional bore between the water main and meter within the house..

No pre-bid meeting is required.

Bid submissions shall include one USB storage device and two copies (one marked "Original" and one marked "Copy") submitted together in one sealed envelope/package and received by the City Clerk's Office no later than 2:00 PM local time, on March 31, 2026.

All timely received bids will be publicly opened and read.

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City of Romulus Clerk until 2:00 PM local time, on March 31, 2026. All bids should be clearly addressed:

Contract documents shall be on file after 1:00 PM, March 17, 2026, at the City of Romulus Clerk's Office.

Bid security in the form of a Certified or Cashier's Check or bid bond for a sum no less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid.

The City of Romulus reserves the right to accept or reject any bid or waive irregularities in Bids. No Bid may be withdrawn for a period of one hundred twenty (120) calendar days after the scheduled closing time for receipt of the Bids. A contract may ultimately be awarded to the lowest most responsive and responsible company, as determined in the sole discretion of the City of Romulus or otherwise in a manner deemed by the City to be in its own best interest. This is a Federally funded project. The contractor and subcontractors must comply with Davis-Bacon Wages, American Iron and Steel (AIS), Build America, Buy America (BAB) and other requirements as set forth in the bid documents.

Neither the submission of nor acceptance of any bid shall constitute a contract between any bidder and the City of Romulus. No such contract shall exist without first being approved by a formal action of the members of the Romulus City Council and only after all required bonds and proof of insurances and copies of endorsements have been received by the City and the agreement is signed by authorized representatives of the City of Romulus and the successful Bidder.
