Motion carried by all members present. **STUDY SESSION TOPIC Item 1. CDBG FY2011-2015 FIVE YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN PRESENTATION BY CHRIS PLUMMER, ASK DEVELOPMENT SOLUTIONS, INC.** Canton Township receives revenue from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in the form of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. In order to continue to receive these dollars, the Township's Five (5) Year Consolidated Plan needs to be updated. On November 9, 2010, the Township Board approved the hiring of ASK Development Solutions to assist staff with the development of the Consolidated Plan. Mr. Plummer, President, ASK Development Solutions, reviewed the previous plan and discussed with the Board of Trustees and citizens Canton's current needs and priorities. **Overview:** The Consolidated Plan: Requirement of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to receive federal funds in block grants, Prepared in order to receive federal grant assistance from HUD programs, A comprehensive strategy developed by the community, Addresses the affordable housing and community development needs in the community, Used to implement the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), and Neighborhood Stabilization Program (NSP). Establishes priorities for assistance and the allocation of resources Five Year plan-previous one was FY 2005-2009. Current plan FY 2010-2014, To be completed and submitted to HUD by April/May 2011 **Item 2. SOLID WASTE MASTER PLAN ISSUES** The presentation was a general review of the Solid Waste Management program. The life span of Sauk Hills Trails, Gas recovery program at Sauk Hills, Compost Program, Recycling Program and proposed amendments to the Canton Waste Recycling Contract were discussed.
