or incurred at the time this amendatory Ordinance takes effect are saved and may be consummated according to the law enforced when
they are commenced. This amendatory Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any right pending before the effective date of this amendatory Ordinance. SECTION 3. VIOLATION AND PENALTY. Any person, corporation, partnership or any other legal entity
who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance or any of the regulations adopted in pursuance thereof,
shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof may be fined not more than $500.00 or imprisonment for not more than
ninety (90) days, or both, in the discretion of the Court. SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, subsection, clause, phrase or
portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be
deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion hereof.
SECTION 5. CONSTRUCTION OF ORDINANCE. This Ordinance shall be liberally construed in such manner as to best effectu-

and consistent with the provisions of all existing Ordinances of the Township and all amendments thereto. SECTION6. REPEAL OF
CONFLICTING SECTIONS. Portions of the Code of Ordinances, Part I, Chapter 74 are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary
to give this amendatory Ordinance full force and effect. SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE. This section provides that this Ordinance
