

Charter Township of Canton Board Proceedings – November 27, 2018

A Study Session meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Charter Township of Canton was held Tuesday, November 27, 2018 at 1150 Canton Center S., Canton, Michigan. Supervisor Williams called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. **Roll Call** Members Present: Anthony, Foster, Graham-Hudak (arrived at 6:02 p.m.), Siegrist, Slavens, Sneiderman, Williams Members Absent: None Staff Present: Director Faas, Director Trumbull, Township Engineer – Bill Serchak, Accounting Manager – Sarah Clay **Adoption of Agenda** Motion by Siegrist, supported by Anthony to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously. **STUDY SESSION: Topic 1. Canton's 2019 Road Improvement Program** Director Faas presented a PowerPoint outlining the breakdown of what has been accomplished on the 2019 Canton Road Improvement Program. The session concluded with a question/answer session with the board and residents in attendance. **Board Comments:** Trustee Graham-Hudak asked if the repairs in subdivisions would be asphalt or concrete. Serchak commented the repairs would be completed in accordance with existing materials. Trustee Anthony asked about a warranty on the repairs/work being done. Serchak explained how warranties work. Clerk Siegrist asked about costs of various projects that were completed in the township over the past few years. He inquired about how large portion projects are handled. Serchak explained the township will still be investigating federal grants as well as monitoring the projects Wayne County will have in the future. Treasurer Slavens requested the letter of interest be placed on our website for subdivisions to submit. Faas explained the local roads list will be submitted at the Study Session Trustee Sneiderman asked about how the design phase is handled. Director Faas covered the steps in this process and where Canton is in this process. Sneiderman asked about bonding to cover the costs. Director Trumbull explained how a "loan" works with the state and the process for repayment by the township. Sneiderman asked about projects for 2020 on major roads. Faas explained that should be revealed by spring of 2019. Trustee Foster asked if an HOA is interested in a project will the township work with them to determine what it might cost. Director Faas replied yes. Clerk Siegrist asked what will happen to the 15% allocation to state roads after the Ford Road project is completed. Director Trumbull commented it all depends upon the right-of-way acquisition portion and how much remains. **ADJOURN:** Motion by Siegrist, supported by Foster to adjourn at 7:27 p.m. Motion carried unanimously. **Michael A.
